- Documentation including contribution to Functional Specifications, Detailed Design documents, Test Specifications and Unit Test documents.

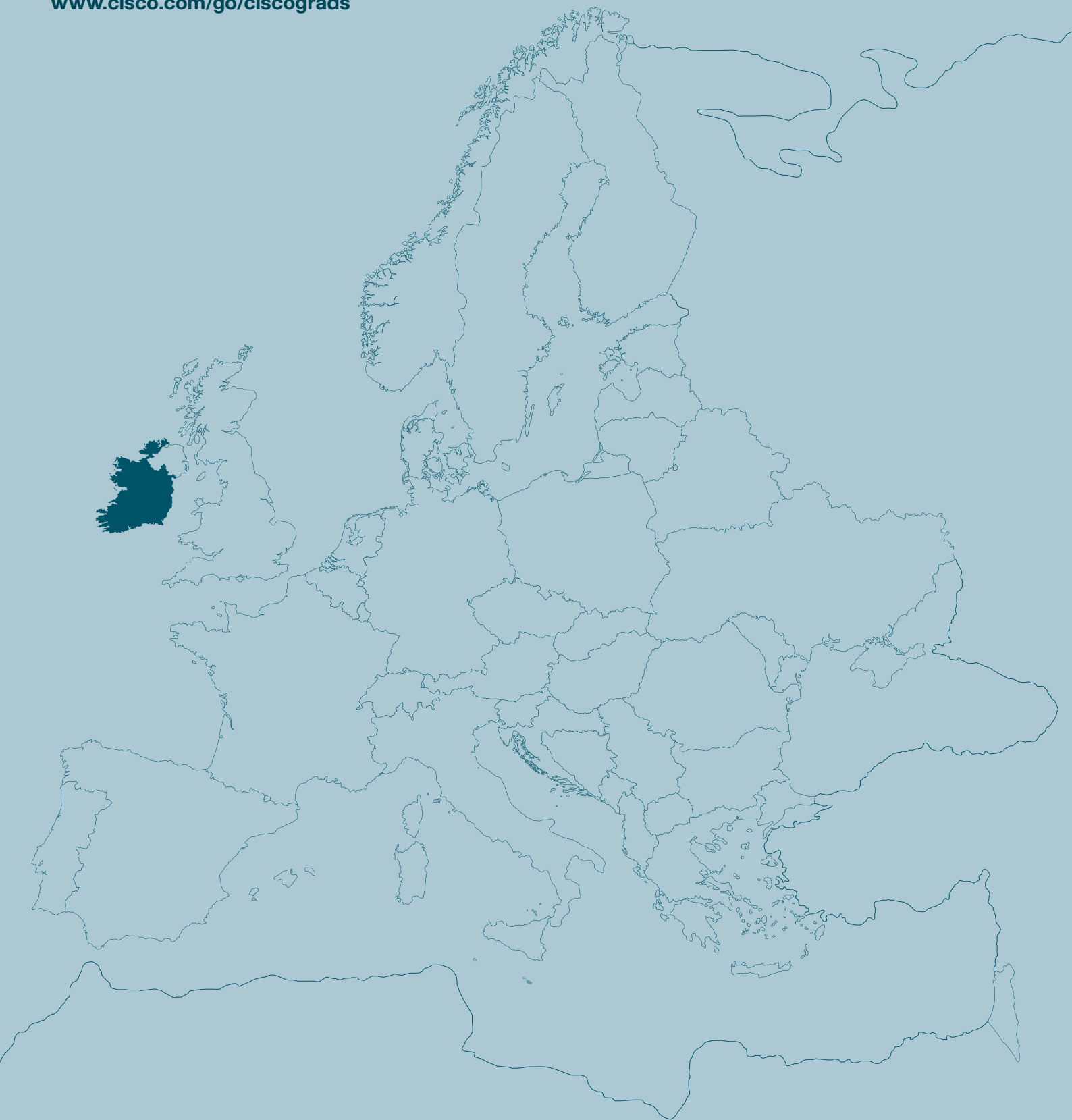
Graduate Software Test and Quality Assurance Engineer
