Lorica is a Latin word literally meaning body armour and may refer to one of the following:

One of a number of types of Roman armour:

A hauberk of chainmail: Lorica hamata.

A shirt of metal scales: Lorica squamata.

A shirt of ribbed scales resembling feathers: Lorica plumata.

A cuirass of metal plates: Lorica segmentata.

Lorica, was the name given by the Romans to the historic city now known as Loriga, Serra da Estrela in central Portugal.
